

- > Stefan W. Hell, one of the winners of the Nobel Prize for Chemistry 2014 was awarded an MCA postdoctoral Individual Fellowship in 1996: 'a critical moment in my career'.
- 30 scientists supported by the FP7 MCA were involved in the 2012 discovery of the Higgs Boson at CERN.
- waves brought a new way to observe some of the darkest events in our universe. An FP7 MCA project contributed to the breakthrough with 14 early-stage researchers, coordinated by the European Gravitational Observatory.








COFUND BUDGET CALCULATION

- The EU contribution must be used exclusively as contribution to the management of the programme and to the living allowance of the researchers
- A top-up (funded through other resources including EU programmes other than Horizon 2020), to cover other cost items (such as research costs, travel, family and mobility allowances, and indirect costs) may be paid to the researchers in order to complement this contribution.


