

**GENERAL AGREEMENT**  
between  
**UNIVERSITY OF SARAJEVO**  
Sarajevo, Bosnia & Herzegovina  
and  
**NORWEGIAN UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY**  
Trondheim, Norway

It is the intention of the University of Sarajevo (UuS) and the Norwegian University of Science and Technology (NTNU) to enhance scholarly co-operation between the two institutions in general, and within the framework of the 'South-Eastern European Programme' (SEEP) in particular.

Goals of this Agreement are to provide faculty and students with opportunities for education and research, based on humanistic values and advanced scientific knowledge. Parties to this Agreement shall at the same time endeavour to jointly achieve a wider international collaboration, particularly within the region of South Eastern Europe.

The field of co-operation shall include, but not be limited to:

1. **Academic Exchange and Training**  
encompassing faculty, scholars, students and library services.
2. **Joint Research and Consulting**  
within law and democratic development; human rights; economic development; architecture; urban planning; and post war recovery studies.
3. **Training Certificate Programs**  
also encompassing courses conducted at a future intra-regional network for higher education and other co-operating universities.
4. **Publishing**

The first phase of co-operation will be to apply for the funding of pilot projects within 'SEEP'.

For this phase the executive institutions shall be  
UNIVERSITY OF SARAJEVO;

Faculty of Economics, and Faculty of Architecture,  
NORWEGIAN UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY;  
Faculty of Social Sciences and Technology Management; Dept. of Economics,  
Faculty of Architecture, Planning and Fine Art;  
Dept. of Architectural Design and Dept. of Town and Regional Planning

Other institutions may be included in accordance with future development of the joint enterprises.

The parties agree to proceed with collaboration planning and implementation as soon as possible.

This Agreement shall take effect upon the approval of execution by the appropriate authorities of both parties. Either party to this agreement may, upon settlement of contractual obligations towards any third party, and by written notice to the other party, terminate this contract of co-operation.
