Collaboration Agreement between

UNIVERSITY OF SARAJEVO

and

WARSAW SCHOOL OF ECONOMICS

1. Introduction

The Warsaw School of Economics and the University of Sarajevo agree to work together on a programme of collaboration in mutually agreed areas of interest and benefit to both partner institutions.

2. Aims and Objectives

The collaboration agreement aims to:

- * promote joint teaching and research activities in the partner institutions;
- * offer opportunities for collaboration to the students and faculty of both partner institutions.

3. Collaborative Activities

The partners will seek opportunities to:

- * promote staff exchange collaboration on research, teaching and professional development activities;
- * offer students of the partner institutions opportunities for collaborative study and research;
- * collaborate on seminars, conferences, short courses and other joint activities:
- * promote the exchange of teaching and research materials;
- * seek funds to develop links between the two institutions.

The terms of any particular joint program or activity shall be discussed and agreed upon in writing prior to their initiation.

4 Co-ordinators

A designated member of staff will be responsible for the promotion of the collaboration agreement in each of the partner institutions:

The co-ordinators will:

- * act as a first point of contact within their institution for all issues related to the collaborative agreement;
- * promote the collaborative agreement within their home institution;
- * organise the exchange of agreed study and research materials;
- * periodically review and evaluate the collaborative agreement.

5. Terms of the Agreement

This agreement shall be effective upon approval by both parties and shall remain in effect for an initial period of five years. Thereafter it shall be automatically renewed from year to year. Each of the partner institutions will reserve the right to terminate the agreement following the written submission of intent to terminate at least six months in advance. Each of the partners will seek to ensure that the interests of participating students or staff are not jeopardised through termination of the agreement.
