A Memorandum of Cooperation between

King Saud University - Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and

University of Sarajevo

King Saud University and University of Sarajevo, Desiring to achieve a fruitful cooperation between the higher education institutions in both the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and Sarajevo in the field of higher education and academic cooperation, and to increase common understanding in the educational process as well as the methods scientific guidance and research, Have agreed as follows:

Article One

The two universities shall actively work towards encouraging cooperation between them in the field of higher education in accordance with what is stipulated by the rules and regulations in both countries.

Article Two

The two universities shall work towards the exchange of visits by the members of the teaching staff in various fields to give lectures, exchange experience and participate in scientific conferences and symposia, provided that the host university shall pay all the accommodation and living expenses, and the sending university shall pay the travel expenses.

Article Three

The two universities shall work towards the exchange of books, syllabuses and printed publications that are

published in universities as well as the research results and scientific periodicals the two universities publish in the scientific periodicals and fields.

Article Four

The two universities shall support and encourage the exchange of visits by specialized officials and members of the teaching staff in both universities; and shall consult with one another to conduct joint scientific research.

Article Five

The two universities shall support and encourage the students' activities, scholarships and the exchange of students' visits according to the available facilities. They shall also facilitate the acceptance of postgraduate students in accordance with the rules and regulations applied in both countries.

Article Six

The two universities shall support and promote the programs of the teaching of languages that are of interest to each of them.

Article Seven

The two universities shall work towards the exchange of students in accordance with the following:

1- One of the two universities shall send, each year, not more than one student, whether he is a graduate or he is about to graduate in order to join the other university. It was agreed that the number of exchange students between the two universities shall be equal during the five-year program.

- 2- The students joining this program shall be selected by the university they belong to on the basis of scientific excellence and competence to study in the host university. A list of the students' names and their details shall be sent in advance to the host university in order to approve their acceptance in the program. The host university shall reserve the right to reject the candidates, in which case extra candidates can be nominated.
- 3-Acceptance in this program shall be restricted to the students who do not hold a scientific degree; and the grades of the joining students shall be sent to the universities they belong to. The student shall stay for one academic year in the host university, which shall send his academic record to the university he belongs to.
- 4-This program shall be subject to rules and regulations applied in the host university and the host country; moreover, the students joining the program shall enjoy the rights and privileges enjoyed by the students of the host university.
- 5- The students joining the program are entitled to participate in any programs or primary courses that are prepared by the host university to foreign students.
- 6- The students shall pay all the relevant expenses to the university they belong to in order to join the program, and they shall be exempted from paying tuition fees to the host university.
- 7-Both universities shall exert possible efforts to help students find a suitable accommodation. The students joining the program shall pay for the accommodation, travel and medical insurance expenses as well as living expenses. The university shall not

bear any financial burden of these expenses. The students nominated for joining the program must prove for their universities that they have sufficient financial means to and from them, and that they have enough money to pay for their living expenses during their stay there.

8- From King Saud University and the International Educational Center from Sarajevo University shall be the two bureaus in charge of running the students' exchange program.

Article Eight

The signing of this memorandum shall not prevent either other activities that would enhance cooperation in consultation between the two universities in the future in a manner that would achieve their common interest.

Article Nine

This memorandum shall take effect from the day it is signed in accordance with rules and regulations applied in both countries, and for five years.

Article Ten

This memorandum shall end by the end of its period unless one of the two universities notifies the other in writing that it intends to renew the memorandum, and the other university approves that at least three months before the expiry of the memorandum. This memorandum shall be revised during two years and each university shall suggest any additions or amendments.

Article Eleven

This memorandum was signed in Riyadh on 21/4/1429 H. corresponding to 27/4/2008 of four copies, two in Arabic

and two in English, and each university shall keep two copies of this memorandum. In case of any difference in the interpretation of the articles of this memorandum, the Arabic text shall prevail.
