Letter of General Agreement

It is the intention of LOYOLA UNIVERSITY OF CHICAGO ("LOYOLA") and the UNIVERSITY OF SARAJEVO to enhance the scholarly collaboration between the two institutions, to provide their students with opportunities for educations based on human values and the advancement of knowledge, and to cultivate among their students a strong sense of leadership which will allow them to play important roles in the futures of their home countries and the world.

To achieve these goals, the UNIVERSITY OF SARAJEVO and LOYOLA agree to collaborate on investigations of certain activities. These activities shall include, but are not limited to:

- 1. Academic Exchanges
 - (a) faculty
 - (b) scholars
 - (c) students
- 2. Joint Research and Consulting
 - (a) economic development
 - (b) law and democratic institutions
 - (c) education
 - (d) medical
 - (e) other
- 3. Training Certificate Programs
- 4. Collaborative Communications Projects
 - (a) radio programming
 - (b) Internet development
- 5. Establishment of Special Center to Serve Chicago Bosnian Community
 - (a) creation of special certificate from the UNIVERSITY OF SARAJEVO for Chicago Bosnian students meeting certain requirements and standards of study, in conjunction with the BOSNIAN HERZEGOVINIAN AMERICAN COMMUNITY CENTER
 - (b) transmission of UNIVERSITY OF SARAJEVO student transcripts and employee records

LOYOLA and the UNIVERSITY OF SARAJEVO agree to assess their progress on these and any other collaborative efforts no later than four (4) months following execution of this agreement,, at which time they may amend or modify the agreement accordingly.

Letter of Agreement -- 1

This Letter of Agreement shall take effect upon the approval of and execution by the appropriate authorities of both parties. Either party to this agreement, by written notice to the other party, may terminate this agreement.
