General Objectives

UNSA-FF and Med Uni Graz (MUG) seek to establish a cooperation that builds on mutual research interests in cell cultures, biomembrane models and animal experiments, with a focus on understanding the nutrients, other food constituents and drugs effects.

Specific Objectives

The specific goals of this strategic cooperation between UNSA-FF and Med Uni Graz (Division of Biomedical Research) are as follows:

- to develop joint research projects, based on common research interests in basic and applied biomedical life sciences
- to promote exchange of personnel for training and know-how transfer
- to exchange know-how and promote technology development
- to further increase international visibility as partners for collaborations

General Provisions

• The details of each activity developed under this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) (including projects, duration, conditions, financing, distribution of tasks, admission requirements, intellectual property, liability, logos, publications, dispute settlement, etc.) will be specified and agreed upon in writing in separate contracts before the respective activity takes place. Each specific agreement shall be approved by the appropriate authorities of the contracting institutions.

 Neither party will use the name, trade name, trademark, logo or other designation of the other party in connection with any products, promotion, advertising, press release, or publicity without the prior written permission of the other party.

 The parties acknowledge the merits of positive publicity but they recognize that neither party should make any press announcement or public statement about the proposals or this MOU which has not been agreed in advance by the other party.

 UNSA-FF and Med Uni Graz will each identify a person ("the Co-ordinator") who will be responsible for the implementation of the cooperative programs under this MOU.
