AGREEMENT ON ACADEMIC COOPERATION

Between

UNIVERSITY OF JYVÄSKYLÄ

And

UNIVERSITY OF SARAJEVO

Recognising the mutual benefits to be gained through educational and research cooperation and through strengthened contacts between faculty members and students of the two universities, the University of Jyväskylä, Finland, and the University of Sarajevo, Bosnia and Herzegovina, hereby agree to enter into a cooperative agreement.

Article 1.

The purpose of this agreement is to facilitate and develop cooperation and mobility between the **University of Jyväskylä** and the **University of Sarajevo**. Subject to mutual consent, the areas of cooperation can include any field represented at both universities.

Article 2.

Cooperation shall be carried out through such activities as:

- Exchange of teachers, researchers and administrative staff;
- Exchange of undergraduate, graduate and/or doctoral students;
- Organization of special short-term academic programmes, such as intensive summer schools and seminars;
- Exchange of academic materials and university publications;
- Exchange of information and experience in the utilization of new information and communication technologies;
- Exchange of information and experience regarding the implementation of the Bologna process.

Article 3.

The terms of cooperation for each specific activity implemented under this agreement shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both parties prior to the initiation of that activity. All activities mentioned in the Article 2 will be based on reciprocity. The parties to this agreement aim at making a concrete annual action plan detailing the forms and fields of cooperation to be implemented in the framework of the agreement. These action plans can be changed or amended by mutual consent of the two universities.

Article 4.

This cooperative agreement shall remain in force for a period of five (5) years from the date of the last signature with the understanding that it may be terminated by the appropriate authorities of either party giving six months notice to the other party in writing, unless an earlier termination date is mutually agreed upon. The agreement may be amended or extended by mutual written consent of the two parties. This agreement shall be governed by the laws of Finland.
