



**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING  
BETWEEN  
INDONESIA DEFENSE UNIVERSITY  
AND  
UNIVERSITY OF SARAJEVO  
ON  
ACADEMIC COOPERATION**



The Indonesia Defense University and the University of Sarajevo hereinafter referred to as "Parties",

**Wishing** to establish cooperation in promoting academic, educational, and cultural cooperation between the two institutions,

**Taking into account** the friendly and cooperative relations between the Republic of Indonesia and Bosnia and Herzegovina that established on 1994,

**Desiring** to strengthen friendly relations between the two countries in education and strategic research in defense and security study,

**Recognizing** the importance of strategic research on current international and defense and security issues,

**Affirming** the need to carry out cooperation in accordance with the laws and regulations of each country,

**Have agreed as follows:**

**ARTICLE I  
OBJECTIVE**

This Memorandum of Understanding, (hereinafter referred to as the "MoU," ) is to provide a framework for cooperation Agreement for institutional cooperation, and will facilitate further development and consideration of specific programs of cooperation of mutual interest for both Parties.

**ARTICLE II  
SCOPE OF COOPERATION**

1. Cooperation will be implemented through but may not be limited to, the following activities:

- a. Networking and mutual exchange of teachers, research personnel, students and other staff for lectures , visits and sharing of experiences;
- b. Joint educational, training and/or research activities;
- c. Joint organization of conference, symposia, congresses, seminars, courses, summer schools, workshops and other forms of cooperation of mutual interest;
- d. Exchange of professional literature, textbooks and other university publications; and
- e. Exchange of information in fields of interest.

### **ARTICLE III IMPLEMENTATIONS AND FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS**

1. For the implementations of this MoU, Parties will jointly develop specific arrangements, programs, and projects within the scope of this MoU subject to the availability of fund and personnels of Parties. Neither institution shall have any financial obligation to the other institution based on this MoU.
2. The Parties shall keep regular consultation in the implementation of this MoU in order to prepare arrangements, programs and projects aiming at attaining the objection of this MoU.
3. The Financial and administrative arrangement of the above mentioned programs and other mutually agreed-programs made under this MoU shall be determined by the Parties on a case by case basis for their implementations.

### **ARTICLE IV IMPLEMENTING AGENCIES**

## **ARTICLE V INTELECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS**

1. Each Party shall respect, within its territory, intellectual property rights of the other Party, in accordance with the domestic laws in force in their respective Countries.
2. In the event that any specific arrangement, programs, or projects may result in the creation of intellectual property, the Parties shall conclude separate arrangement in relation to intellectual property in accordance with their respective laws, rules and regulations.

## **ARTICLE VI CONFIDENTIALITY**

1. Classified and restricted data and information of both parties will be treated in accordance to national laws and regulations of both Parties.
2. The Parties shall ensure that the scientific research data, result of research and other information which are mutually provided, obtained, and developed, as a result of the implementation of this MoU, will not be transferred or supplied to a third Party without the prior consent of the other Party.

## **ARTICLE VII CODE OF CONDUCT**

1. Each Party shall ensure that its personnel engaged in the activities under this MoU shall respect the laws and regulations of the host country and avoid any activities inconsistent of this MoU.
2. The Parties who have issued a permit reserves the rights to revoke the permit granted or to proceed to related authority to personnels who have performed any activities inconsistent with the purposes and objectives of this MoU.

## **ARTICLE VIII SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES**

Any difference between the Parties arising out of the interpretation or implementation of any provisions of this MoU will, in the first instance, be jointly settled by mutual consultation between the Parties, or through diplomatic channels if necessary.

## ARTICLE IX AMENDMENT

Amendments and changes will be possible only in case of written consent by the Parties. Such amendments shall enter into force on such date as may be determined by the Parties and shall form an integral part of this MoU.

## ARTICLE X ENTRY INTO FORCE, DURATION AND TERMINATION

1. This Agreement will become effective upon the date of signature by representatives of the institutions.
2. This Agreement will be force for five (5) years and may be renewed upon mutual consent both parties.
3. This Agreement may be terminated before the expiry of the five (5) year period only upon the written consent of the Parties. Either party wishing to make changes or terminate the MoU shall notify the other institution in writing of such intention at least six (6) months before the intended date of termination
4. The termination of this MoU shall not affect the implementation of the on going programs, projects, and activities made under this MoU.
