## PROTOCOL ON ACADEMIC COOPERATION BETWEEN ANKARA UNIVERSITY AND UNIVERSITY OF SARAJEVO

Ankara University and University of Sarajevo have agreed to cooperate in order to improve, strenghten and promote mutual collaboration.

I

Ankara University and University of Sarajevo , will strenghten their academic relations and cooperation.

Mutual assistance will be provided for the training and development of academic staff.

Knowledge and experience will be exchanged and joint projects in various scientific and educational fields will be set up.

П

Within the general framework described in Article I, the two parties have agreed to cooperate and to take required to realize the goals listed below.

- 1. Both parties will benefit from each other's knowledge and experiences to find solutions to the scientific problems of mutual interest.
- 2. Both parties will exchange academic staff in order to benefit from each other's experiences and knowledge.
- 3. Both parties will mutually support research staff and student exchange in the fields of common interest.
- 4. Books, other various publications and materials to be used for education, training and research purposes will be exchanged.
  - 5. Both parties will mutually encourage the organization of scientific meetings.
- 6. Joint research works in the fields of common interest of the both parties will be supported.

Exchange of academic staff, students, yearly quotas, duration of stay will be defined in a seperately prepared working programme and the same programme will cover the details of joint projects explained in Article II.

IV

To make this Protocol operational, working programme, that determines form and details of cooperation can be rearranged every year in accordance with the proposals of the parties to meet the new demands and requirements.

V

When necessary top level administrators from both universities will make observe and supervise the operation and efficiency of this Protocol and related working programme.

VI

Within the constraint of the budget; the sending party will cover travelling expenses from origin to destination city, whereas the receiving party. will cover accommodation and other related expenses in the country to be visited

VII

This Protocol will remain valid for three years and will be automatically prolonged for another three years unless termination is required by one of the parties in the form of written notice six months prior to expiry,

VIII

This Protocol is prepared in Turkish and in English, two copies of each. All versions are the same and equally valid.
