

BILATERAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT

between

KARL-FRANZENS-UNIVERSITY GRAZ

and

THE UNIVERSITY OF SARAJEVO

To reflect the mutual interest to further and expand the existing co-operation, the **University of Sarajevo** and **Karl-Franzens-University Graz** hereby agree to renew the following agreement in the field of scientific co-operation and teaching:

Article 1

The objective of this agreement is to encourage the co-operation between **Karl-Franzens-University Graz** and the **University of Sarajevo** (later in the text: both universities) in all fields represented by both universities.

Article 2

The co-operation between both universities will particularly enhance and initiate following activities:

- mutual linkages and exchange of staff, faculty, and students;
- summer schools, seminars and other activities to exchange knowledge;
- exchange of scientific and scholarly literature, textbooks and other university publications
- organising joint research projects, joint publications and joint programmes
- exchange of experience
- co-operation within frameworks like TEMPUS and other European programs;

Article 3

The details of each activity developed under this agreement (projects, duration, conditions, financing, distribution of tasks, conditions for admission etc.) will be specified and agreed upon in writing before the respective activity takes place. The details of recurring forms of cooperation will be specified in annexes to this agreement.

Article 4

The realisation of the activities will be evaluated annually.

Article 5

This agreement takes effect upon ratification by the representatives of their universities, Rector or Vice Rector, and will be valid for five years.

After a positive assessment, the agreement can be extended for a further three-year period.


The agreement may be terminated upon written notice by either party, but only after ongoing activities have been completed.

Article 6

This agreement has been drawn in two copies in English, each to be considered originals, each university to keep one original.

Any amendment to this agreement may be made on the exchange of letters between the two parties.
