



**Memorandum of Understanding
between Philipps-Universität Marburg, Germany
and University of Sarajevo, Bosnia and Herzegovina**

Philipps-Universität Marburg and University of Sarajevo wishing to intensify the existing cooperative relations between the two institutions, especially to develop academic and cultural interchanges through mutual assistance in the areas of education and research, agree as follows:

1. Participating parties

The participating parties will be Philipps-Universität Marburg (UM) and University of Sarajevo (UNSA). Both institutions adhere to Article 2 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR) and do not discriminate on the basis of race, colour, sex, language, religion, political or other opinion, national or social origin, property, birth or other status.

2. Area

The area of cooperation includes, subject to mutual consent, any program offered by either of the participating parties as felt desirable and feasible on either side to foster and develop the cooperative relationship between the two institutions.

3. Methods

Assistance shall be carried out, subject to availability of funds and the approval of each institution, through such activities or programs as:

1. Joint research activities
2. Exchange of faculty members and research students
3. Participation in seminars and academic meetings
4. Exchange of academic materials and other information
5. Special short-term academic programs
6. Exchange of students
7. Other activities as deemed mutually appropriate

The terms of such mutual assistance and necessary budget for each program and activities shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both parties prior to the initiation of the particular program or activity, and such program and activity shall be negotiated on a mutual basis.

4. Principles

Both parties assert that participants under this Memorandum of Understanding will be selected on the basis of the merit without regard to race, national or ethnic origin, color, religion, age, sex, marital status or physical handicap. UM and UNSA will each accept the participants selected by the other party if mutually acceptable academic and/or professional qualifications and standards are met. All participants will be treated in the same non-discriminatory manner in carrying out the provisions of this Memorandum of Understanding, subject to the provision of the policies and requirements of each of the institutions. Any violation of these principles will be considered as grounds for terminating this Memorandum of Understanding.


5. Effective Date and Length of Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding will remain in force for a period of 5 years subject to the availability of funds, and any amendment and/or modification of the Memorandum of Understanding will require written approval of the signing authority of each contracting institution and shall be appended hereto. After the initial 5 year period, this Memorandum of Understanding may be renewed automatically.

Either party reserves the right to terminate this Memorandum of Understanding upon six months written notice to the other.

This Memorandum of Understanding shall take effect when signed by each side.
